### **State Aid Programs**

- HELP Higher Education Legislative Plan Grant
  - Need: Pell-eligible; income; 20 ACT; 2.5 GPA; Curriculum
  - Award: Full tuition
- MTAG Mississippi Tuition Assistance Grant
  - Residency: NOT full Pell; 15 ACT; 2.5 GPA
  - Award: F/S \$500; J/S \$1,000
- MESG Mississippi Eminent Scholars Grant
  - Merit: 29 ACT; 3.5 GPA
  - Award: \$2,500



### **General Policies**

- Full-time, continuous enrollment
- 15 earned hours = full-time for state aid
- State follows federal guidelines for dependency status
- Residency for state aid is NOT the same as residency for tuition
- State accepts grades/GPA reported by school ONLY




